

**PERSPECTIVE OF THE CLIENTS TOWARDS
OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY**

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ABSTRACT:

The overall purpose of this qualitative study was to explore the clients perspective towards Occupational Therapy who was received their intervention. Purposive sampling was used to select five participants and Semi-structure interview was conducted for data collection. The results were presented with case-summary by performing the coding system of the data. From the case-summary, five main themes were produced and summary of the themes are:- Clients were- (i) able to recall the Occupational Therapy services, (ii) difficulty to remember the word 'Occupational Therapy,' (iii) not happy by themselves for not being cured, but was happy with Occupational Therapy Intervention, (iv) suggested to make posh and equipped department, (v) recommended that Occupational Therapist and Doctor should get equal status and respect.

The significance of the findings for Occupational Therapy is discussed and areas for further research are suggested.
